

We are required by the Bar Standards Board to publish an anonymised summary of chambers' diversity data in respect of all barristers and staff once every three years.


Halcyon chambers have a total of 21 barristers including tenants, door tenants and pupils, and a total of 4 members of staff.

For the purpose of diversity data collection, 6 barristers (29%) and 4 members of staff (100%) responded to the request.


We have made every effort to ensure that, so far as is possible, save where express consent has otherwise been given, that no individual can be identified from the anonymized data.




GENDER IDENTITY: Barristers

Is your gender identity the same as the sex that you were assigned at birth?





Is your gender identity the same as the sex that you were assigned at birth?




DISABILITY: Barristers

Do you consider that you have a disability according to the definition in the Equality Act?





Are your day-to-day activities limited because of a health problem or disability which has lasted, or is expected to last, at least 12 months?





Do you consider that you have a disability according to the definition in the Equality Act?






RELIGION OR BELIEF: Barristers









If you went to University (to study a BA, BSc course or higher), were you part of the first generation of your family to do so?





Did you mainly attend a state or fee-paying school between the ages 11 - 18?







Did you mainly attend a state or fee-paying school between the ages 11 - 18?





Are you a primary carer for a child or children under 18?




